Dear parishioners and friends:

The Journey

When first elected, Pope Francis wrote an Exhortation called *The Joy of the Gospel*. In this work, he outlined his vision for the Church. His vision is for people to encounter the love of Jesus in their heart and to share the Joy of the Gospel with others as missionary disciples. The Pope's universal vision for the Church, is my vision for our parish. In the fall, our parish will begin a program called *The Journey*. *The Journey* is a new resource from Paulist Evangelization Ministries designed to help Catholics of today deepen their personal relationship with Christ. It is a simple and direct way to encounter Jesus in our lives. The program will be offered in English and Spanish and for our youth as well. The planning team seeks to offer the program on different days and at different times to allow as many as possible to participate.

There are three Parts in *The Journey* program and each part contains 6 sessions. We plan to offer the program in the fall, during Lent, and after Easter. Part 1, focuses on our personal encounter with Jesus. In Part 2, participants reflect on what it means to belong to Jesus' community, the Church. In Part 3, the sessions explore how we encounter Jesus' way of life as disciples. In the sessions, a powerful video is shown followed by scripture, prayer, and discussion. In the videos, we see how our experiences today are reflected in the experiences of those who first encountered Jesus two thousand years ago. We come to see how Christ touches us personally even today.

Stay tuned for more information in the weeks ahead, including a preview of one of the short videos at Mass. We are all on a faith journey to encounter God's love in our life. I pray this program brings us closer to Christ, to each other, and helps us share the joy of the Gospel with those searching for meaning in their life. I hope you can join us on *The Journey*.

El Viaje

*Cuando fue elegido por primera vez, el Papa Francisco escribió una Exhortación llamada La Alegría del Evangelio. En esta obra, esbozó su visión para la Iglesia. Su visión es que la gente encuentre el amor de Jesús en su corazón y comparta la Alegría del Evangelio con otros como discípulos misioneros. La visión universal del Papa para la Iglesia es mi visión para nuestra parroquia. En el otoño, nuestra parroquia comenzará un programa llamado **El Viaje**. **El Viaje** es un nuevo recurso de los Ministerios Paulistas de Evangelización diseñado para ayudar a los católicos de hoy a profundizar su relación personal con Cristo. Es una manera sencilla y directa de encontrar a Jesús en nuestra vida. El programa se ofrecerá en inglés y español y también para nuestros jóvenes. El equipo de planificación busca ofrecer el programa en diferentes días y en diferentes momentos para permitir que participen lo más posible.*

Hay tres partes en el programa y cada parte contiene 6 sesiones. Planeamos ofrecer el programa en el otoño, durante la Cuaresma, y después de Pascua. La primera parte, se centra en nuestro encuentro personal con Jesús. En la segunda parte, los participantes reflexionan sobre lo que significa pertenecer a la comunidad de Jesús, la Iglesia. En la tercera parte, las sesiones exploran cómo encontramos el modo de vida de Jesús como discípulos. En las sesiones, se muestra un poderoso video seguido de escritura, oración y discusión. En los videos, vemos cómo nuestras experiencias hoy se reflejan en las experiencias de aquellos que encontraron a Jesús hace dos mil años. Llegamos a ver cómo Cristo nos toca personalmente aún hoy.

*Estén atentos para más información en las próximas semanas, incluyendo una vista previa de uno de los videos cortos en la Misa. Todos estamos en un camino de fe para encontrar el amor de Dios en nuestra vida. Ruego que este programa nos acerque a Cristo, los unos a los otros, y nos ayude a compartir la alegría del Evangelio con aquellos que buscan un significado en su vida. Espero que puedan unirse a nosotros en **El Viaje**.*



The 20/20 Project - UPDATE

In early June, thirty people interested in respect life issues from across the Camden Diocese gathered in Our Lady of Grace chapel to hear Christine Flaherty of LIFENET speak about the 20/20 Project. Our parish's Hospitality Ministry and Respect Life Ministry organized the evening and served to welcome those who visited us for this meeting. Christine, who has headed this special project for over a year, described the efforts across New Jersey to attain equal rights for babies in the womb. The first goal of the Project is to pass the "Pain Capable Unborn Child Protection Act" by the year 2020. This legislation would ban abortions after 20 weeks, since science has shown that the child in the womb can feel pain by 20 weeks. All previous attempts at passing pro-life legislation in NJ to ban abortions have failed to make it through the legislative process to become law. So Christine knew that the goal for a first step for the new project had to be something small and measurable, and attainable. She saw some success in other states with legislation banning abortions at the point when it was demonstrated that a child in the womb can feel pain; so she set the goal of having abortions after 20 weeks banned by the year 2020 in NJ. Then she began meeting with pro-life leaders of all denominations to encourage them to work together toward this goal.

As of our meeting, she had the following organizations collaborating on this Project: the dioceses of Newark, Metuchen, and Paterson; the New Jersey Family Policy Council, Corazon PURO, New Jersey Right to Life, the New Jersey Catholic Conference of Bishops, and the Knights of Columbus.
